BCA Member Code of Conduct

All members of the BCA are entitled to membership rights, and shall be treated equally and without discrimination, subject to the BCA constitution and this Code of Conduct.

In becoming a member of the BCA you are required, at all times, to follow all aspects of the following:

- Members must treat one another with courtesy and respect.
- Members must refrain from any form of harassing, bullying or abusive conduct. This
 is defined as behaviour which is likely to cause alarm or distress to another person
 or make them feel uncomfortable.
- Members must observe the law and never do anything to bring the BCA into disrepute.
- Members must not act in a negative or destructive manner towards the BCA, its events, employees, or its elected committee.
- Members must respect the property and facilities provided by the BCA.
- Members are responsible for taking reasonable care over their health and safety and assessing any risks to themselves or others of their participation in club events.
- Members shall observe any reasonable directions from the BCA, any event organiser or other responsible party in relation to their health and safety.
- If a member brings a non-member guest, or child into the BCA the member is responsible for ensuring that they always follow this code of conduct.
- If bringing a child into the BCA then the member is responsible for ensuring the child is always under supervision and not left alone, without appropriate supervision, in any part of the BCA. Note: The BCA or its staff are not responsible for taking on the responsibility of any aspect of the supervision of a child whilst on the BCA Premises.
- Should a guest or child (for whom the member is the responsible person)
 misbehaves and not follow all of the above Code of Conduct then the member will
 receive the same penalty as if they themselves had not followed the code of
 conduct.
